

A STATUTE TO MAKE PROVISION FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF SPECIAL COMMISSIONERS TO PRADESHIYA SABHAS SPECIFIED IN SCHEDULES IV AND V OF LOCAL AUTHORITIES (SPECIAL PROVISIONS) ACT NO. 38 OF 1988 AND FOR MATTERS CONNECTED THEREWITH AND OR INCIDENTAL THERETO

BE IT PASSED BY THE PROVINCIAL COUNCIL OF THE WESTERN PROVINCE OF THE DEMOCRATIC SOCIALIST REPUBLIC OF SRI LANKA.

Short title

1. This Statute may be cited as the ^{Western Province} Local Authorities (Special Provisions) Statute No. 07 of 1990.

Appointment of Special Commissioner

2. (1) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in any other law, the Minister of the Board of Ministers to whom the business of Local Government has been assigned may by Order published in the Gazette appoint a Special Commissioner to administer the affairs of any Pradeshiya Sabha specified in Schedule IV or V to the Local Authorities (Special Provisions) Act No. 38 of 1988.

(2) The Divisional Secretary of the Division within which the Office of the Pradeshiya Sabha is situated shall be the Special Commissioner referred to in Sub-section (1).

(3) The appointment of a Special Commissioner referred to in sub-section (1) shall, unless otherwise specified in the Order, be of effect till elections are held to such Pradeshiya Sabhas specified in sub-section (1) of this Section.

(4) Where a Special Commissioner appointed under sub-section (1) of this Section to a Pradeshiya Sabha vacates his substantive office of Divisional Secretary by death, resignation, dismissal or otherwise, the Minister may appoint his successor in the office of Divisional Secretary as Special Commissioner to administer the affairs of such Pradeshiya Sabha.

Conflict or inconsistency with any other law.

3. Where there is a conflict and inconsistency between the provisions of this statute and any other law, the provisions of this statute shall prevail over the provisions of that law.
